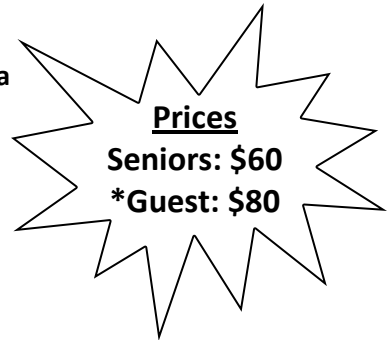

RELEASE OF LIABILITY - READ BEFORE SIGNING

In consideration of _____ [student's name] being allowed to participate in the Seven Lakes High School Project Prom, its related events and activities, I, the undersigned, acknowledge, appreciate, and agree that:

1. FOR MYSELF, SPOUSE, CHILD AND/OR WARD, I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL RISKS associated with the event, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and assume full responsibility for my, my child's or ward's participation and for anything that may occur to me, my child or ward while participating in Project Prom.
2. I, for myself, my spouse or child/ward, and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS the SEVEN LAKES HIGH SCHOOL PROJECT PROM BOOSTER CLUB, and all of its officers, directors, officials, agents, subcontractors, members, volunteers and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and the Katy Independent School District ("Releasees"), WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH, LOSS OR DAMAGE TO PERSON OR PROPERTY, arising from my or my child/ward's activities, WHETHER ARISING FROM NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, except for willful misconduct, or otherwise to the fullest extent of the law.

AGREEMENT TO ARBITRATE DISPUTES

In the event of any dispute pertaining to any provision of this agreement, or pertaining to the services rendered pursuant to this agreement, or in any way related to attendance at this event, including any claim for personal injury or other loss, EACH PARTY HERETO AGREES TO SUBMIT TO BINDING ARBITRATION TO RESOLVE SUCH DISPUTES, before the American Arbitration Association in Houston, Texas, or such other venue as deemed appropriate by the AAA arbitrator, such arbitration to proceed under the AAA rules. In the event either party to this agreement incurs any expense as a result of the other party's failure to comply with any provision of this agreement, the non-complying party shall be liable for reimbursement of any and all such expenses or attorney fees directly or indirectly related to failure to comply. In the event any legal action or proceeding occurs this is in a manner related to or pertaining to this agreement, attempting to challenge in a non-arbitral forum such as a court of law the validity or application of this agreement, the party who substantially prevails in that court or non-arbitral proceeding shall be entitled to receive reasonable costs of such action or proceeding, including attorney's fees. The following disclosures are intended to help you thoroughly understand the significance of agreeing to arbitrate any controversy, or claim, or issue in any controversy or claim which may arise between the parties to this Release:

A) Arbitration shall be final and binding on the parties; B) The parties hereto are waiving their right to seek remedies in court, including the right to jury trial; C) Pre-arbitration discovery is generally more limited than and different from court proceedings; D) The arbitrator's award is not required to include factual findings or legal reasoning and any party's right to appeal or to seek modification of rulings by the arbitrator(s) is strictly limited; and E) The arbitrator or panel of arbitrators will typically include an attorney or judge, active or retired.

By signing below, I am stating I am eighteen years of age, or I am parent or legal guarding for the participant identified above, with full authority to agree to the terms contained in this Release.

I HAVE READ THIS RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND SIGN IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT INDUCEMENT.

Expectations And Protocol

The purpose of Project Prom is to have a celebration for SLHS seniors and their guests, which is free of any illegal, disruptive, or disrespectful behavior, including consumption of any alcohol, tobacco products, or drugs. The event is organized and sponsored by the SLHS Project Prom 2011 Booster Club.

1. The attached Permission Slip and Liability Release forms (two-sided document) must be read, completed in full, and returned with the appropriate signatures when purchasing tickets for Project Prom. **Separate forms** are required for SLHS Seniors and their guests, even if they are already 18 years old. Make additional copies as needed. Seniors are allowed to bring one guest.
2. Tickets will be sold at school during lunches before the event. **Tickets will NOT be sold at the door.** Only ticketed seniors and ticketed guests will be admitted.
3. All SLHS seniors and their guests are expected to arrive at Project Prom in a sober and drug-free state.
4. **The Official Project Prom T-shirt serves as your ticket and MUST be worn to the event. NO CHANGING OF CLOTHES WILL BE ALLOWED AT SCHOOL.**
5. Check-in for Project Prom will begin at 12:00 a.m. on Sunday, May 22nd at SLHS. Check-in concludes promptly at 1:30 a.m. Seniors or guests arriving after that time will be denied access. **No refunds.**
6. An attempt will be made to contact parents or legal guardians in the event a ticketed senior or ticketed guest does not show up to Project Prom or if access is denied for any reason. **Parents will be contacted after the initial check-in is completed at approximately 2:00 a.m.**
7. All attendees **must park in the Student Parking Lot located behind SLHS** (or be dropped off at the back entrance of SLHS) and are required to ride the designated buses to the event. For safety reasons, it is recommended that students arrange for pick up from SLHS at approximately 6:00am-6:15am on Sunday morning, May 22 in the student parking lot behind the school.
8. To enter Project Prom, seniors and their guest **MUST be wearing their official Project Prom T-shirts, which serves as their ticket.** Additionally, they will need an **acceptable photo I.D.** (i.e., school photo I.D. or photo driver's license). Failure to meet these requirements will result in denial of access to the event. **No Refunds.**
9. No purses, backpacks, or other bags will be permitted. Hip bags will be provided to all seniors and their guests for cell phones, keys, and cameras. The First Aid Station will stock all necessary personal items to meet the needs of seniors and their guests.
10. No senior or guest will be released from Project Prom prior to 6:00 a.m. on Sunday, May 22. If an urgent need arises to leave the event, **the parent or legal guardian will be contacted to pick up their student.** No one leaves without that permission being secured by an authorized Project Prom representative. **No exceptions.** If an attendee is given permission, through the correct protocol to leave Project Prom, **the attendee may NOT return.**
11. If problems arise on the night of Project Prom, they will be handled by authorized Project Prom parent representatives and/or Katy ISD Police or Houston Police who will ensure that a safe, secure environment is maintained. The presence of professional security is required and customary at Project Prom. Should a problem arise, an attempt to contact the parents or legal guardians at the phone number provided will be made.
12. All guests are expected to adhere to the same rules as their host.
13. Only SLHS Seniors are eligible for door prizes and gifts.
14. Minor medical first aid will be available. Over the counter pain medication will be dispensed by the Project Prom nurse if authorized on the signed permission slip.
